
Whoa! Look at that

On July 16, 1779 in Stony Point, New York a battle occurred which was the Battle of Stony Point. There was around 2,962 people in the battle that's pretty big. Sadly there was 15 killed and 83 wounded for the Americans and 94 killed and 472 captured for Great Britain. Anthony Wayne was the commander for the U.S. He received the nickname "Mad Anthony" for the ensuring maneuver. Which he was manipulating. It was his highest point for his American Revolution War service. He was born on January 1, 1745 in Easttown Township Provice of Pennsylvania. He died in Fort Presque Isle near Erie Pennsylvania. He has participated in 10 battles.
